

Treuddyn Circular Walks - No 2

Distance 2 ½ miles
Allow 1 ½ hours

This walk has some fabulous views of Nercwys Forest with Moel Famau in the background. Nercwys Forest was planted in 1965 with a mixture of lodge pole pine, Sitka spruce, noble fir and larch. Today it is part of the Clwydian Range AONB where walkers, cyclists and horse riders are encouraged to enjoy the scenery and wildlife.

Start in Village Community Centre car park on Queen Street

1 Walk up the path by the side of the Community Centre to the road.

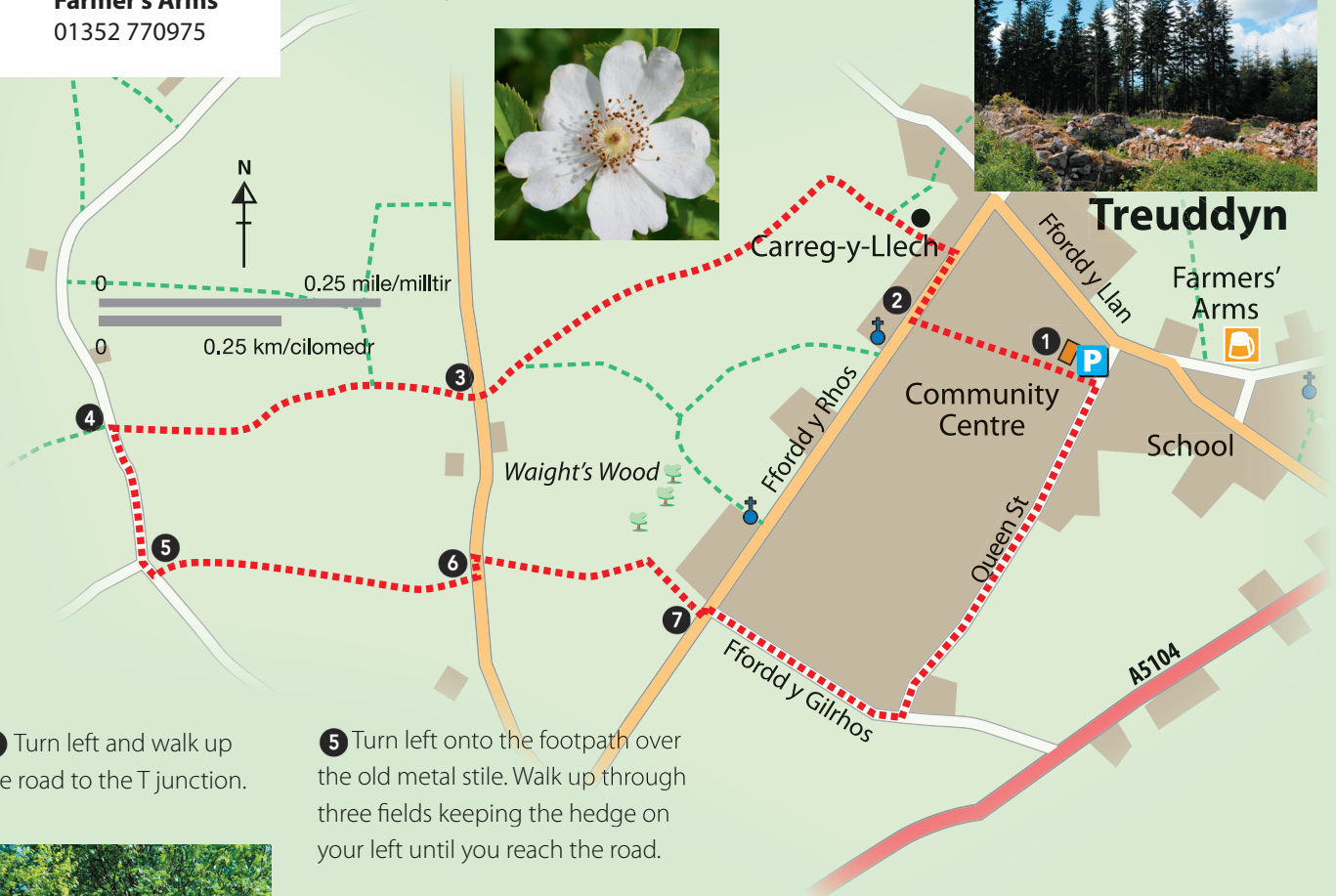
2 Turn right onto the road and then left onto the footpath between the houses. Carry on past the Carreg y Llech field and continue along the path by the house and over the stile. Walk down the field to the fence, then turn left and go over the stile in the corner. Turn left and follow the path on the far side of the hedge. Go through the gate, around the old quarry/pond and bear left up the field to the stile.

3 Cross over the road and go over the stile opposite. Walk down the field edge, go over the stile and then go down the field, over the stile in the remains of the hedgerow and continue down the field to the stile by the road.

4 Turn left and walk up the road to the T junction.

5 Turn left onto the footpath over the old metal stile. Walk up through three fields keeping the hedge on your left until you reach the road.

6 Cross over the road and go over the old stone stile opposite. Follow the path along the hedge, go over another stile and then carry on straight ahead to a third old stile in the hedgerow opposite. Turn right and follow the path through two wooden kissing gates to the road.

7 Cross over and walk down Ffordd y Gilrhos opposite. Follow the road around to the left and then turn left into Queen Street and back to the car park.
